October 25, 2024



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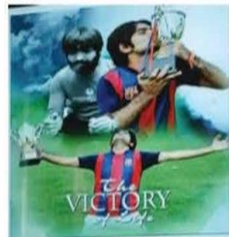

October 23- 26, 2024

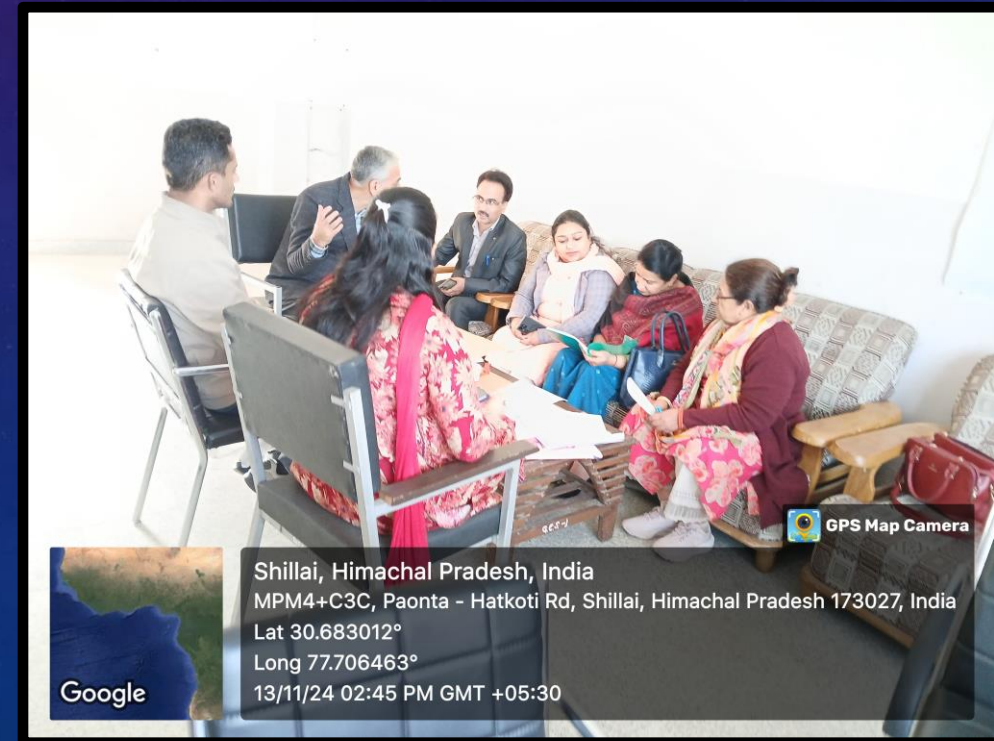

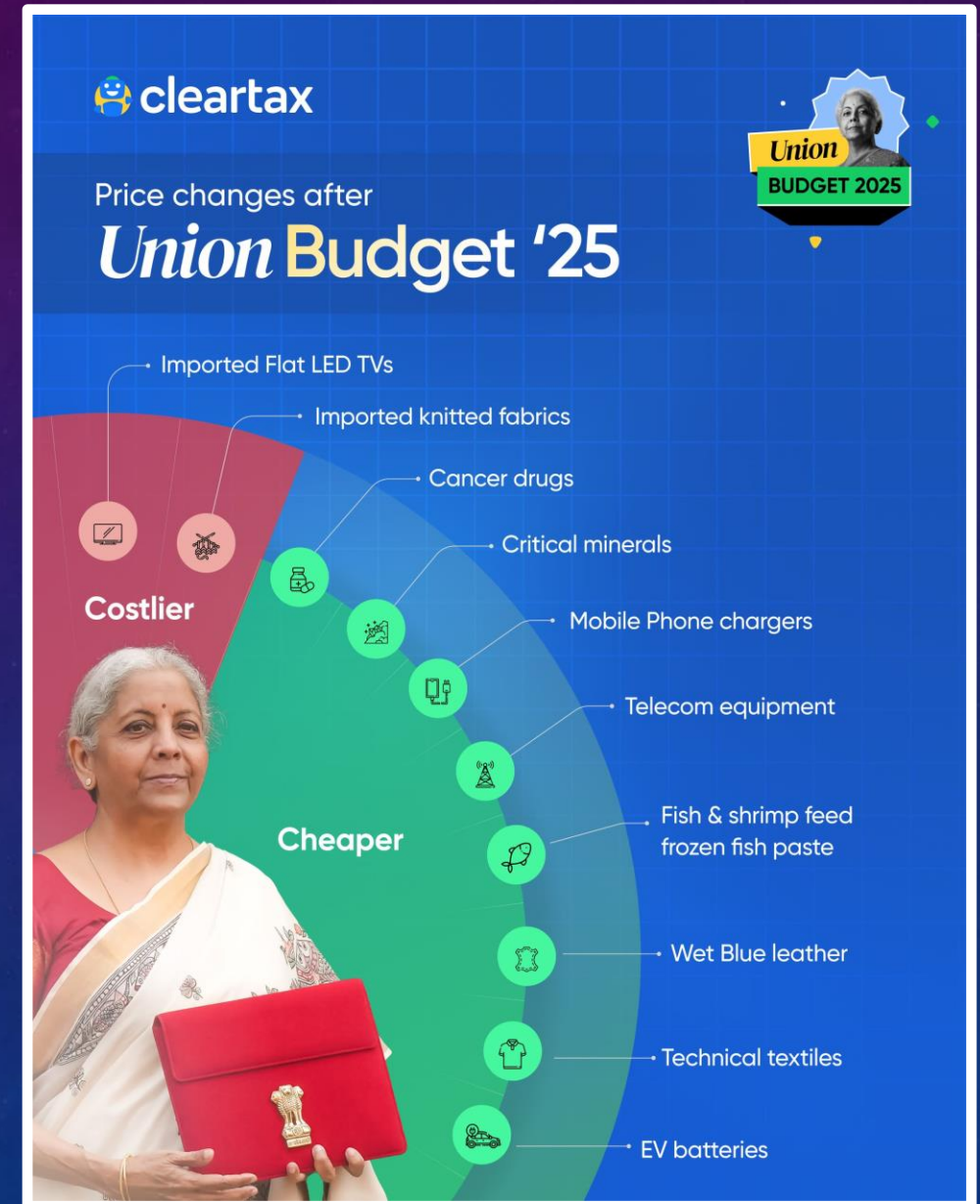

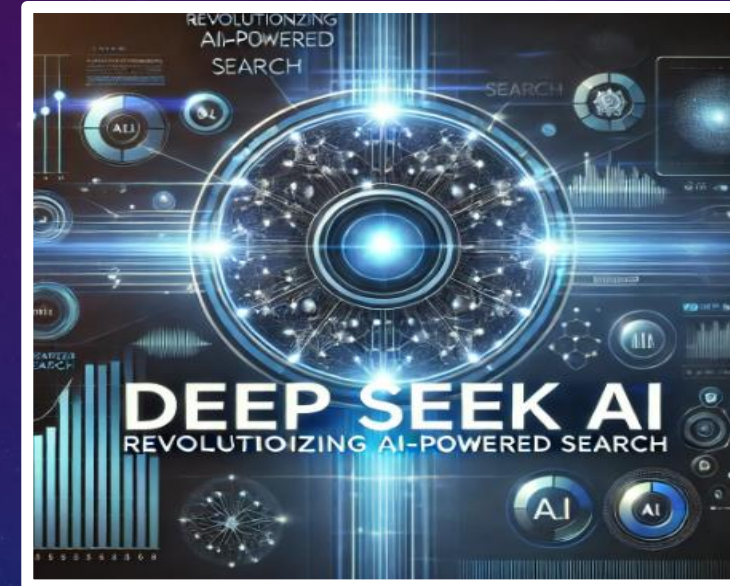

It can provide answers to your queries with unimaginable speed and accuracy, collected from different resources. There are various AI-powered chatbots available these days, and the whole world is in a race to create more powerful AI chatbots to win this competition. Some of the chatbots available today include ChatGPT by OpenAI, Gemini by Google, and DeepSeek, among others. Prompt engineering is also very crucial when someone is desirous to generate an image using AI. This requires the specific, minute and in depth details to be entered to obtain a creative and more realistic image. The image obtained is significantly dependent upon the prompt that the user has entered. So the key to use AI effectively is, the art to ask appropriate query, and it also forms the basis of future of human – AI collaboration.
